If you haven't been to Border War before what can you expect?


* Fighting in heavy armour, both on the war field and in tourneys.

For Newcomers: Some of our members train for heavy and rapier fighting at home. These are NOT official events, they are NOT covered by insurance, and you attend at your own risk. If interested in joining one of these training sessions, you will need to be-friend the person running the training.

Numbers are slightly down on last year, as some memberships have lapsed. Reminders have MEMBERSHIP: been sent out by the Seneschal. Membership really is a good deal, \$45 per adult per annum saves you an extra \$10 insurance for each event you attend in the year. Even if you only attend 3 events you are already saving money; and Bordescros holds 2 events per month plus Border War each year (that's 25 events) and it also saves you insurance on any events you attend elsewhere in the Kingdom: Royal events, Festival, etc. What a bargain!
